**For Conference Room Team:** You must have been on a <u>Walk to Emmaus</u> 3-Day Weekend as a pilgrim prior to serving on the conference room team. (Does not have to be at Great River)

For all other service teams: You need to have been on a 4<sup>th</sup> Day-type 3-Day Weekend in order to serve on the service teams (ex. kitchen, Agape Chapel, Work Room, etc.)

For example: If you have been on Cursillo, Via de Cristo and similar events, you can help serve!!
